

Steps 1 2 3 4 5 6

There are 6 easy steps to register as a supporter with eScrip. The first step of the registration process is for you to identify the school, group or organizations that you would like to support. Your [privacy](#) is important to us at ESI. We have taken security measures to protect your information.

Search to see if your group is enrolled with the program.

- Group Name
- Group ID
- City where Group is Located
- Zip Code where Group is Located

Enter your personal contact information. Then you can register the following:

- Grocery Cards
- Debit/Credit Cards

Remember, you can register more than one card for each category. Register the cards of friends and family, if possible.

eScrip Dining

Go to: <http://escrip.rewardsnetwork.com>

From the home screen, you can search participating restaurants by Zip code, City/State, or Name.

Note: The school is only credited if you use the debit/credit card registered with eScrip to pay the restaurant bill.

Note: Ralphs requires you to re-register your cards each year.
